MCT / Import Custom Media Information (.am1 file)


Media Configuration Tool (MCT) is a software developed by Canon that allows the user to import (or export) .am1 files. This file contains precise settings for custom media like : head height, vacuum strength, black ink type, maximum ink capacity and calibration.

You can import a Canon Media Information File (.am1) that has been saved in a folder, and add the file to the printer control panel and to the printer driver of the PC or Mac you are using. For more information read the MCT manual and follow Canon instructions.


IMPORTANT NOTE : Please make sure you are using the appropriate media file (.am1) and corresponding ICC profile for the media type you are printing on. The ICC profiles are built utilizing these supplied .am1 files* and are required for accurate results while using the corresponding ICC profiles*.

Method step by step :


1. Open the Add and Edit Custom Paper dialog box.



2. Click the Import button.




3. Select the folder with Custom Media Information File (.am1 file) to import.




4. Click the next button.

5. The Confirm Update dialog box opens.



6. Click the Execute button.

7. If needed, click the Edit button to adjust head height, vacuum strength or cut method.
